ARE YOU READY FOR ECLIPSE DAY?

On Monday, April 8, the Moon will pass directly between the Sun and Earth creating a total solar eclipse. In Marble Falls, the event will last from 12:17 to 2:57 pm, with "totality" (complete darkness) starting at 1:36 pm and lasting for 4 minutes, 14 seconds.

We are in a prime location for viewing, and an influx of tens of thousands of visitors is expected. Make sure to plan ahead for this rare event by following these tips:

- ✓ Expect heavy traffic from April 4th through April 9th.
- ✓ Burnet, Llano, and Marble Falls schools will be closed on April 8^{th.}
- √ Fill your gas tank the weekend prior to the eclipse.
- ✓ Buy needed supplies ahead of time (medications, groceries, water, eclipse viewing glasses, etc.)
- ✓ Do not schedule appointments or errands on April 8th.
- ✓ Coordinate with your employer if working from home is an option on April 8th.
- Cell and internet service may be overwhelmed with additional crowds. Make a back-up communication plan.
- Remember that local aid and first responders will be in extreme demand during the event.
