INSTILLING A SENSE OF CURIOSITY IN OUR CHILDREN

It's "Back to School" time, and this month we discuss how to instill a sense of curiosity in our children.

Instilling curiosity is vital for a child's intellectual and emotional development. Curiosity fuels their desire to learn and explore the world around them, fostering creativity and critical thinking. To nurture this innate trait, parents and teachers should create an environment that encourages questions and exploration.

<u>Start by modeling curiosity yourself.</u> Show enthusiasm for learning new things and share your discoveries with your children. Ask open-ended questions and engage in discussions that stimulate their minds. Providing a variety of resources such as books, educational games, hands-on activities, and field trips, can spark an interest in new and varied subjects.

<u>Outdoor activities</u>, like nature walks or visits to parks and playgrounds, expose children to new experiences and ideas. Allow them to pursue their interests and support their endeavors, whether it's building a model, conducting a simple science experiment, or exploring a new hobby.
